# Overview

Use this procedure to install PaymentMate Windows Edition (PMWE). There are two options:

1. Manual Installation Utilizing Installer Interface Prompts
  2. Installation from Command Prompt

# Requirements/Dependencies/ Limitations

Prior to installation, the following are required:

1. Payment device drivers for either the card reader and/or check scanner
    - a. Payment device drivers must be installed prior to installing PMWE
    - b. Review the applicable device driver installation articles for more details.
  2. (If applicable) Card reader and/or accessories related to the card reader
  3. (If applicable) Check scanner and/or accessories related to the check scanner
  4. PMWE Installer

## Step-by-Step Process

# Option 1: Manual Installation Using Installer Interface Prompts

Select and launch an installer application and follow the interface's prompts to complete installation of the PMWE software.

**Note:** Installation requires access to certain folders and registry files. Tempus highly recommends the installation occur using an elevated administrator credential.

| Step | Step Description  |
|------|---|
| 1    | Tempus will provide a PMWE installer based on the merchant's desire. Ask your Network Administrator to determine the best installer for the deployment.<br><ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Executable Installer (EXE)</li><li>2. Microsoft Software Installer (MSI)</li></ol>  |
| 2    | Launch the installer, then select <b>Install PaymentMate</b> .<br><ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. If <b>Do you want to run or save..</b> message displays, select <b>Run</b>.</li><li>2. If <b>Do you want to allow the following program to make changes to this computer</b> message displays, select <b>Yes</b>.</li></ol>  |
| 3    | Installer launches and displays a <b>Welcome</b> page. Select <b>Next</b> .   |
| 4    | Read <b>Important Information</b> page. Select <b>Next</b> .  |
| 5    | Read <b>License Agreement</b> page:<br><ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Select the <b>I Agree to these Terms and Conditions</b> check box.</li><li>2. Select <b>Next</b>.</li></ol>   |
| 6    | Read <b>Installation Options</b> page:<br><ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Select/unselect <b>Create a Desktop Icon for PaymentMate Windows Edition</b></li><li>2. Select/unselect <b>Have PaymentMate Windows Edition start when my computer starts</b></li></ol>  |
| 7    | Select <b>Install</b> . PMWE installs.  |
| 8    | <b>Installation Completed</b> page displays.<br><ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>i. To start the application, select the <b>Start PaymentMate Windows Edition when I close Setup</b> check box.</li><li>ii. Select <b>Finish</b> to close the installer. The next step is Activation. Refer to <b>PaymentMate Windows Edition (PMWE)-Activating</b> procedure for activating instructions.</li></ol> |

# Option 2: Install from Command Prompt

**Note:** Installation requires access to certain folders and registry files. Tempus highly recommends the installation occur using an elevated administrator credential.



| Step | Step Description  |
|------|---|
| 1    | Add the desired installer file to a C drive folder.   |
| 2    | Open <b>Command Prompt</b> and navigate to the location where the installer resides.  |
| 3    | Type the desired <b>Command Prompt Argument</b> and press <b>Enter</b> . See <b>Command Prompt Arguments</b> below for options.   |
| 4    | Installer launches.   |
| 5    | (If UI Enabled) <b>Installation Completed</b> page displays. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The next step is Activation. Refer to <b>PaymentMate Windows Edition (PMWE)- Activating</b> procedure for activating instructions.</li> </ol> |

## Command Prompt Arguments

Enter one of these arguments in Step 3 above.

| Microsoft Software Installer | Run installer unattended/silent and disable the creation of the desktop shortcut*                     | <code>msiexec /i C:\pmlite.msi /q \$ShortcutDesktop=2</code>                                 |
| Microsoft Software Installer | Run installer unattended/silent and disable the creation of the startup folder shortcut*              | <code>msiexec /i {path to file}\pmlite.msi /q \$ShortcutStartup=2</code>                     |

\*Installers create desktop and startup folder shortcuts by default. These shortcuts cause PMWE to run when a user logs on. These shortcuts can be disabled using command prompt arguments.



# Post Installation Information

After PMWE has successfully been installed:

1. A C:\Spectrum folder path will be created containing:
    - a. PaymentMate.exe
    - b. Supplementary folders/files required for PMWE to properly be processed.
      - i. These files will be read and written to by PMWE, so it is important that both read/write access is given to the application.
  2. Registry entries will be created
    - a. 32-bit Windows Computer: HKEY\_LOCAL\_MACHINE\SOFTWARE\ Tempus Technologies\General Attributes
    - b. 64-bit Windows Computer: HKEY\_LOCAL\_MACHINE\SOFTWARE\Wow6432Node\Tempus Technologies\General Attributes
